





Rudolph The Red-Nosed Reindeer


You know Dasher and Dancer and Prancer and Vixen Comet and Cupid and Donner and Blitzen, But do you recall, The most famous reindeer of all?

Then one foggy Christmas Eve Santa came to say Rudolph with your nose so bright Won't you guide my sleigh tonight?


Then all the reindeer loved him And they shouted out with glee "Rudolph the red-nosed reindeer, you'll go down in history

Christmases be white


