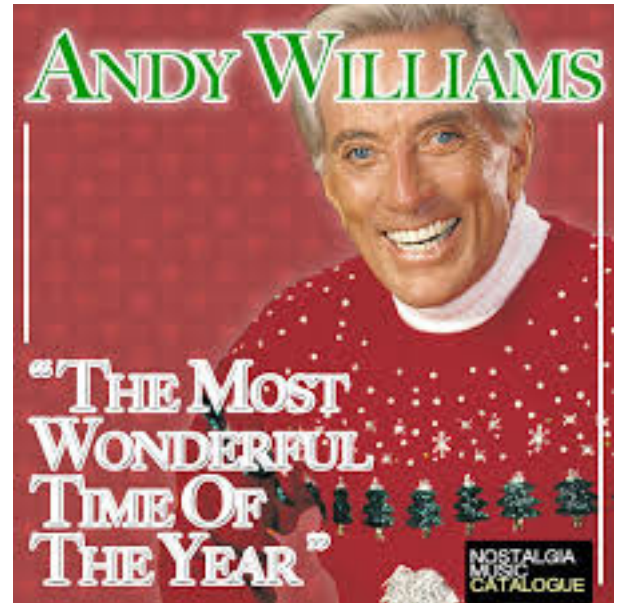

Out of a thousand invitations you received

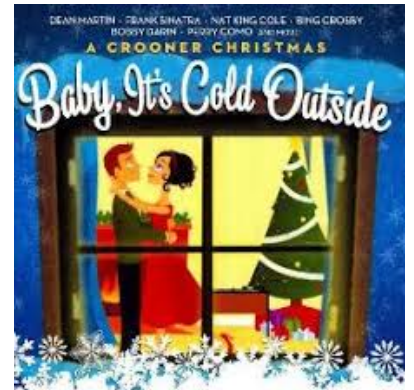
Oh, but in case I stand one little chance

Rudolph The Red-Nosed Reindeer

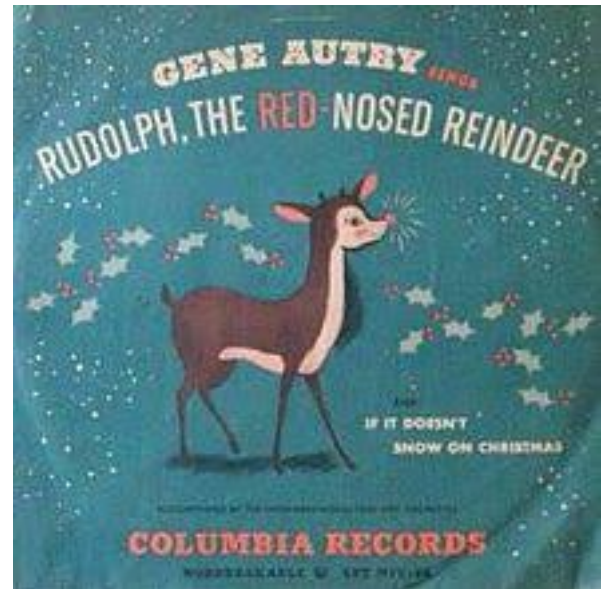
You know Dasher and Dancer
